On behalf of Advanced Water Infrastructure Networks (AWIN), trading as Leaf Water, I certify that:

AWIN's charging schemes in respect of its appointments as the water and/or sewerage undertaker for sites in the areas of Affinity Water, Anglian Water, Bristol Water, Northumbrian and Essex and Suffolk Water, Portsmouth Water, Severn Trent Water, South East Water, South Staffordshire and Cambridge Water, South West Water and Bournemouth Water, Southern Water, Sutton and East Surrey Water, Thames Water, United Utilities, Welsh Water, Wessex Water, Yorkshire Water;

- a) AWIN comply with its legal obligations relating to Wholesale charges it has published.
- b) The AWIN Board has assessed and approved the new Wholesale charges for water supply and sewerage services for licensees who are retailing wholesale services and on customers occupying Eligible Premises (as a whole or in groups) and has assessed the impact an handling strategies development in instances where bill increases for licensees (as a whole or in groups) who are retailing wholesale services and on customer occupying Eligible Premises (as a whole or in groups) exceed 5%.
- c) AWIN has appropriate systems and processes in place (including up-to-date models and data) to make sure that the information published about its Wholesale Charges is accurate.
- d) AWIN will consult on their Wholesale Charges 2026-27 with relevant stakeholders in a timely and effective manner.
