Wholesale Charges Scheme 2026-2027



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Section 1: Introduction

1.1 Introduction

This document provides details of the Wholesale Charges for Leaf Water Limited (the trade name of Advanced Water Infrastructure Networks Ltd, or AWIN) for the period from 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2027 inclusive for the areas in which Leaf Water operates. Please note that wholesale charges for residential properties may differ from those presented here.

This Wholesale Charges Scheme is issued by Leaf Water and outlines its Water and Sewerage Wholesale charges in accordance with the provisions of the Water Industry Act 1991. Under the Act and its Licence, the Company is authorised to set, levy, and recover charges for any services provided in the course of its duties as both a water and sewerage undertaker.

Leaf Water aims to align its wholesale charges with those set by the Supplying Water Company in each area where it operates, as detailed in Section 3 of this Charging Scheme. However, specific requests for wholesale charges, whether for household or non-household properties, will be assessed on a case-by-case basis to ensure charges are cost-reflective. This is because boundary charges can vary considerably between sites, even within the same water company area, and are not always linked to the level of onsite costs.

These Charges only apply within the areas where Leaf Water provides water and/or sewerage services under AWIN's regulatory appointment. The applicable areas are listed in Appendix 1, which is correct as at the date of its publication.

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1.2 Primary and Non-Primary Services

There are two types of wholesale services that we provide:

- Primary services related to the supply of water and the removal and treatment of foul sewerage, surface water drainage, highway drainage, and trade effluent; and
- Non-Primary services for activities that support, but are not directly related to, the provision of primary services

The Non-Primary service charges have been developed to support retailer service requests. These charges have been designed to meet both the Office for Water Regulation (Ofwat) Wholesale Charging Guidelines and the Wholesale - Retail Code.

1.3 Metering

All properties served by Leaf Water are metered. This is the fairest way of charging non household customers and encourages water conservation. We do not offer an unmeasured tariff.

For premises served by a Retail Licensee, that Licensee is responsible for providing meter readings to the Central Market Operating System (CMOS). Leaf Water has opted to partner with Castle Water so should customers not have a selected Retailer, Castle Water will be assigned as their retailer until such time as this is changed by the customer. Charges in this document are stated exclusive of VAT. VAT will be added at the appropriate rate where applicable.

Any alterations to existing premises that result in the creation of additional premises must ensure separate connections to Leaf Water's water main and the ability to install separate meters. Customers are responsible for the costs of necessary pipework alterations.

In cases of illegal connection, the Company may pursue all appropriate criminal and civil remedies.

Section 2: Tariffs Introduction

2.1 Base Water Supply Tariff

Our tariff charges can be made up of three elements:

- an annual fixed charge for the site
- a fixed charge per meter based on its size
- a volumetric charge per m³ of water supplied

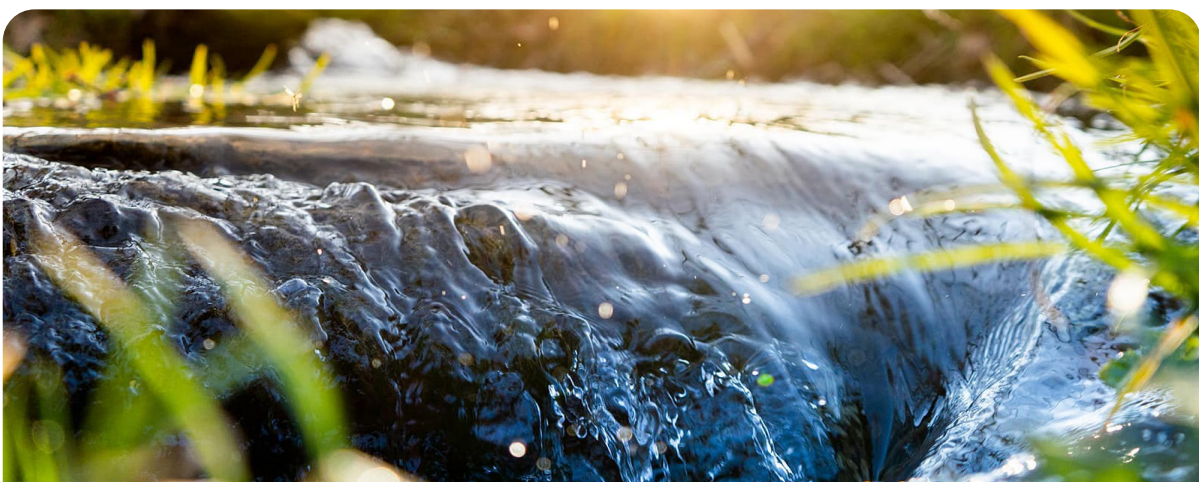
2.2 Base Sewerage Discharge Tariff

We calculate the volumetric sewerage charge on the assumption that between 90% and 100% of water recorded by the meter will be discharged to the sewers, the exact amount will depend on the Supplying Water Company's Return to Sewer percentage. Should a customer be able to show that the volume not discharged is greater than the allowance applied to their premises, we will consider reducing the volume used in the charge calculation by an equivalent amount. The charge can be made up of five elements:

- an annual fixed charge for the site
- an annual fixed charge for highways drainage
- an annual fixed charge for surface water drainage
- an annual charge for surface water drainage based on the surface area of your site
- a volumetric charge per m³ of sewerage discharged

For premises discharging significant quantities of waste, large-user charges may be applied. These charges comprise a reduced volumetric tariff plus standing charges plus a fixed annual charge. The fixed annual charge is set according to the discharge band into which the premises falls. Details of these charges are set out in the tariff tables in this document.

This Charges Scheme does not provide for reduced charges to community groups in respect of surface water drainage from their premises.



2.3 Trade effluent consent and Tariffs

Customers must make an application to their retailer to obtain our permission before discharging trade effluent into our sewerage system; discharging trade effluent without first obtaining consent is a criminal offence. The consent to discharge trade effluent will be issued in the name of the business, at the address of the trade premises, and only permits discharge of the effluent specified. Leaf Water operate as a wholesaler and is responsible for granting a trade effluent consent within our licence area. Leaf Water reserves the right to refuse consent.

For all types of business, trade effluent is charged as a fixed charge and a volumetric charge per cubic meter is calculated according to the strength of the effluent calculated using the Mogden Formula:

$$C = R + V + B_1 + \left(\frac{Ot}{Os}\right)B_2 + \left(\frac{St}{Ss}\right)S$$

Where:

- C is the unit charge per m³ of trade effluent discharged
- R is the unit cost per cubic metre for the reception and conveyance of sewage
- V is the unit cost per cubic metre of the preliminary and primary treatment of the sewage in our wastewater treatment works
- B is the unit cost per cubic metre of the biological oxidation treatment of settled sewage. It consists of two elements:

B_1 is the unit charge per cubic metre relating to the capital costs associated with secondary treatment and

B_2 is the unit cost per cubic metre relating to all other biological oxidation treatment costs

- S is the cost per cubic metre of treatment and disposal of primary sewage sludge
- Ot is the chemical oxygen demand (COD) in mg/l of the trade effluent after 1 hour of quiescent settlement at pH7 or at the pH of the mixed sewage
- Os is the chemical oxygen demand (COD) of average strength settled sewage
- St is the suspended solids in mg/l of the trade effluent at pH7 or at the pH of the mixed sewage
- Ss is mean suspended solids content of all settled sewage at the wastewater treatment works (at a certain mg/l)

Please ask your retailer for an application form to apply for a trade effluent consent and we will specify the tariff you will be charged based on the detail above.

4.1 Non-Primary Charges Introduction
